## 2009 - 2010 Artwork Contest

The Indiana Association of School Principals, Department of Student Programs (DSP) is pleased to announce its eighth annual art contest for students in grades K-12.

Art mediums include:

- Photography: Digital or film, color or black and white
- Painting: Oil, acrylic or water color
- Drawing: Charcoal, Pen & Ink, Pencil, Marker, Crayon

This competition allows an artistic interpretation and perspective as told by each individual entry. Accompanying each entry, the student is required to write a narrative (100 words or less) explaining the role the arts play in his/her life.

Eligibility is limited to Indiana DSP member schools. Each student entry should be no larger than 8 1/2" X 13.5". Only two-dimensional entries submitted no larger than designated size will be considered in judging process for display at Riley Hospital. Be sure to package carefully to ensure no damage in mailing. Submitted artwork becomes the property of IASP as a non-exclusive image. Entry in the contest constitutes permission for IASP to use the artwork for publication and display. Non-winning entries may be picked up at our office or returned if stamped, self-addressed packaging is sent with entry.

Deadline for entry is December 19, 2009. All reasonable care will be taken in handling entries. IASP cannot be held responsible for damage to, or loss of, artwork.

All artwork will be judged anonymously by DSP Advisory Board members and volunteer art instructors. Artwork and entry forms will be numbered upon receipt. Judging will be based on subject, creativity, narrative.

**(Limit 2 entries per person)**

Winners will be announced by March 20, 2010

- **18 "Art for Riley" designees:** Six students at each level will have their entries displayed at Riley Hospital for Children through our annual Art for Riley initiative.
- **12 IASP Office Selections:** Four students at each level will have their artwork displayed at the IASP Conference Center for all IASP members, sponsors, contest entrants and guests to enjoy.

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**CONSENT AND RELEASE AGREEMENT**

THIS CONSENT AND RELEASE AGREEMENT (“Consent”) is entered into between the Indiana Association of School Principals, Department of Student Programs (“IASP”) and \_\_\_\_\_ (“Guardian”), the parent or legal guardian for \_\_\_\_\_ (“Student”), in connection with Student’s selection as one of the winners as a result of Student’s winning entry (“Entry”) in IASP’s Art Competition.

In addition to granting winning Student with award for the Entry, IASP intends to use the Entry, and to attribute the Entry to Student by use of Student’s name, in various publications in order to display and promote the excellence in artistic endeavors, skills and abilities of Indiana school children. Specifically, IASP intends to publish the Entry on the IASP Internet website, and in various IASP publications (collectively, “Promotions”). IASP may additionally choose other media (to be included in the Promotions) for display and promotion of winning entries of the Art Competition, including the Entry.

As a result of the foregoing, Guardian, who represents and warrants that he/she is a person legally authorized to enter into agreements relating to the rights, interests and obligations of Student, consents and agrees, in consideration for the award granted to Student and the notoriety achieved through the Promotions, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, as follows:

1. Consent to Use. Guardian, on behalf of Student, consents to the use of the Entry and the formal name of Student for the Promotions, and hereby grants to IASP an exclusive, perpetual, royalty-free, world-wide license, with the right to sublicense to IASP’s distributors and sub-contractors, to use the Entry and Student’s name as shown above in connection with the Promotions by displaying publicly, copying, distributing copies of, and preparing derivative works based on the Entry.
2. Release. Guardian, on behalf of Student, releases and fully discharges IASP and any and all of its personal representatives, agents, employees, officers, directors and/or assigns from any and all, and all manner of, actions, causes of action, claims or suits, in law or in equity, arising from IASP’s use of the Entry or Student’s name, except for any use in violation of or outside the scope of this Agreement, which Guardian or Student ever had, now has, or may in the future have against IASP, from the beginning of the world until the end of time in accordance with this Agreement.
3. Withdrawal of Consent. Guardian may withdraw the consent and license granted in Section 1 above (i) upon written notice to IASP within thirty (30) days after the date of execution of this Agreement, or (ii) in the event that IASP uses the Entry or Student’s name in any way which is not permitted by this Agreement and which is unflattering or detrimental to Student. [In the event of any such withdrawal, IASP shall have the option to rescind or otherwise request the return of the award to Student, and Guardian, on behalf of Student, shall take all steps and execute all documentation necessary to ensure the prompt return of such award to IASP or its designated agent.]
4. No Assurances. Notwithstanding IASP’s intentions to use the Entry and the Student’s name in connection with the Promotions, nothing contained in this Agreement shall require or otherwise obligate IASP to so use the Entry or the Student’s Name. In the event that IASP fails to use the Entry and the Student’s name in connection with the Promotions within one (1) year from the date of execution of this Agreement, the grant of consent and license from Section 1 of this Agreement shall become null and void without penalty or prejudice to Guardian or Student.
5. Original Work of Student. This Agreement, the use of the Entry and Student’s name in connection with the Promotions, and the award to Student are all conditioned upon the Entry being the sole and original work of Student. In the event that it is shown that the Entry is not the sole and original work of Student, or in the event that an adverse claim to or in the Entry is discovered or arises in the future, Guardian, on his/her own behalf and on behalf of Student, shall indemnify, defend and hold IASP harmless for any and all claims, suits, costs, damages or liabilities suffered, incurred or arising against IASP in connection with IASP’s use of the Entry in connection with the Promotions as consented to and licensed pursuant to this Agreement. Additionally, in the event practicable, IASP shall have the option to rescind or otherwise request the return of the award to Student and Student’s School, and Guardian, on behalf of Student, shall take all steps and execute all documentation necessary to ensure the prompt return of award to IASP or its designated agent.

The foregoing represents the entire agreement between IASP and Guardian of behalf of Student. This Agreement and the terms and provisions contained in it may not be changed orally by either party.
