

Mini-Grant Opportunity from INSPIRE³ program



INSPIRE³ - \$250 Mini-Grants available to educators in Indiana schools to support service-learning projects.

These mini-grants and the support you have available from **INSPIRE³** (formerly generationOn Indiana) is through our grant funded program facilitated by the IASP (Indiana Association of School Principals) and the IMLEA (Indiana Middle Level Education Association). These mini-grants are to be used for service-learning projects to support student engagement in philanthropy education and service-learning at your school. Depending on the demand for our mini-grants, there may be a limit of one or two mini-grants per school per school year. Priority is given to teachers that have not received a mini-grant in the past.

STEPS TO APPLY:

1. The LIVE LINK to our **INSPIRE³** (formerly generationOn Indiana) **mini-grant application** is available to Indiana Educators and Administrators from Joan Belschwender, INSPIRE³ (formerly generationOn Indiana) program Director. Email Joan at joan.inspire3@iasp.org to request the **LIVE LINK** to our online application. **This link is NOT on the generationOn website** because our **INSPIRE³ mini-grants** are funded through our grant funded program that is facilitated by IASP and IMLEA.
2. **Requirements:**
 - a. To apply make sure you are connected to our **INSPIRE³** (formerly genOn IN) **database**. If you have already registered on generationOn.org in the past you are already on our database. **You can also fill out this short form [here](#) to be added to our INSPIRE³ database.** This is the link you can also copy and paste in in your browser.

 - b. Your service-learning project must include using a **Learning to Give lesson** with your students before, during, or after the project. Learning to Give is our collaborative partner. You can do a Lesson Search on www.learningtogive.org . Use all or part of a LTG philanthropy education lesson(s) in whatever way is best for you. **Create an Account on the Learning to Give website** to access all their website content.
 - c. After acceptance of your mini-grant and completion of your service-learning project you will be required to submit data from your project on the **online Service-Learning Tracker that is found your Registered generationOn School account**. Our program uses the generationOn Website's free documenting tool on school accounts, as they are an in-kind partner for our program.
 - d. Registering on the generationOn website will allow you to **Join** your generationOn School account, if your school is registered. Check the Classroom/School page <https://www.generationon.org/page/for-classrooms-and-schools> to see if your school is on their Directory. If it is, you can easily Join it. If it isn't, you can easily Register your school on this same page to have access to this online tracker. Email Joan if you have a question about this step.

Our INSPIRE³ mini-grant application is an online application. Once you start the application you will need to finish it. **Email Joan for the live link.**
